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

The Board considered the revised syllabus prepared by the department in the light of recent changes in the Business Environment and the Government Policy relating to Indirect Taxation. After perusal, it was found that the revised syllabus was in consonance with the Existing Common Regulations governing the P. G. Program in the University.

Hence, it passed the following resolutions:

"Resolved to approve the revised syllabus of the M.Com program to be implemented with effect from the academic year 2018-19".

However, the Board also considered the necessity and relevance of the GST introduced by the Central Government in the current financial year. As the existing Corporate Tax-Planning - II of M.Com 4th Semester consists of earlier Indirect Taxes like Sales Tax, Excise, etc; the Board felt the need for replacing the contents of that paper by the contents of GST Act. Therefore, the Board resolved to recommend for making suitable provision for teaching the said paper at M.Com 4th Semester with the new contents w.e.f. the 4th Semester of Academic Year 2017-18.

The Board also opines and recommends the University that the students have to undergo the Project soon after the completion of M.Com 3rd Semester instead of M.Com 4th Semester, so as to facilitate the students and university to declare the results as early as possible.
